Concrete, dirt, rocks or construction materials  
Televisions, computer monitor tubes,  
Farm machines, cars, trucks  
Fuel cans, gas tanks  
Furniture, mattresses  
General trash  
Hazardous waste  
Mercury switches  
Microwaves  
Oil containers  
Paint cans with paint in them  
Oil – oil should be taken to the City of  
Hartford Street Department  
pressurized cylinders of any kind (welding)  
Propane tanks  
Railroad ties, or treated lumber

- 2.) Please flatten all containers and cardboard boxes
- 3.) Please remove labels if possible
- 4.) Please remove caps & lids from containers
- 5.) Please keep the following items separate:
  - a. Clean cardboard
  - b. Colored cardboard
  - c. Aluminum cans
  - d. Milk bottles
  - e. Tin cans
  - f. Phone books & books with glued spines
  - g. Copper wire
  - h. Christmas lights
  - i. Misc. plastics (soap, lotions, etc)
- 6.) There is a bin for all metal products listed on the front of this flyer
- 7.) Newspapers need to be in paper bags
- 7.) Glass needs to be sorted by color or clear (i.e. brown, green)

There will be receptacles for each item to be placed in at the recycling center. There will be an attendant to assist you should you have any questions or need help.
