

Ordinance No. 2022-01

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE 2050 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF HARTFORD, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Hartford, Washington County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Sections 60.10(2)(c), 62.23, 61.35, and 60.22(3) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Hartford *is* authorized to prepare, adopt, and amend a comprehensive plan as defined in Sections 66.1001(1)(a) and 66.1001(2) of the Statutes.

Section 2. The *Town Board*, by the enactment of an ordinance, formally adopted the document titled, "*Town of Hartford Comprehensive Plan: 2050*," on January 13, 2021.

Section 3. The Town Plan Commission, by a majority vote of the entire Plan Commission at a meeting held on April 6, 2022, recommended to the Town Board the adoption of an amendment to change the land use designation of a parcel of land located at 4678 State Hwy 175, Hartford, WI 53027, T6_005500K from "Agricultural Preservation" to "Medium-Density Urban Residential" on the land use plan map adopted by the Town Board as part of the Comprehensive Plan.

Section 4. The Town published a Class 1 public notice and held a public hearing on April 6, 2022, to obtain public comments regarding the comprehensive plan amendment.


Section 5. The Town Board of the Town of Hartford hereby adopts this Ordinance adopting Amendment No. 1 to the Town of Hartford Comprehensive Plan: 2050.

Section 6. The Town Clerk is directed to send a copy of the plan update to the parties listed in Section 66.1001(4)(b) of the Statutes.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by a majority vote of the full membership of the Town Board and publication or posting as required by law.
